In accordance with FHSAA Officials Guidebook Policy 103.02 (1), "An official who attains Rank 1 status for five consecutive years in a sport (beginning in 2003-04) shall be exempt from the mandatory rules examination in that sport beginning with the sixth year and every other year thereafter as long as he/she maintains Rank 1 status".
